## Reassessment and Replanning of Activities

The Bankers Association of the Philippines (BAP) and the Credit Card Association of the phillppines (CCAP) flied their respective petations for the deferment of the implementation of NTC Memorandum Ciroular No. 04-07-2018 or the migration of 7 -dight to 8 -digit landlin numbers in the Area Code "O2".
following covered areas

1) Metro Manils:
2) Rizal Province
3) San Pedro, Laguna; and
4) San Pedro, Lagun

The BAP's and CCAP's principal reasons for the deferment were as follows:
a) Reprogramming of Point-of-Sale (POS) terminals and supporting network access controllers,
b) Reprogramming of auto-dialers for sales and collection systems as well as onsite alarm systems;
d) Updating of clent phone numbers and period for rigid testing and validation prior
to full migration,
a) Requirement for intensive and expansive information campaign for clients especially those overse
requisite hotlines; and
f) Complance with rules and regulations of regulatory agencies, ie Bangko Sentral ng Plilinas.

BAP and CCAP initially requested for deferment of the implementation to January 2020. Extensive consutations were conducted between the Commission, publictelecommunications entities (PTEs), BAP and CCAP. After the consultations, the Commission, PTEs, BAP and

1. Globe landline dialing 740-0000 in 7-digit format

2. Globe landline dialing 7400-0000 in 8-digit format

## BEFORE MIGRATION

- EG Client can choose to announce a mobile number that can be called during migration.
- Client to announce new hotline number (8 digits)
- Customers should prepare in changing business cards, advertisements, billboards, websites and other materials with (02) 7-digit contact numbers

## DURING MIGRATION

- Contact your dedicated Globe Business Account Manager
- Expect service interruption during the 5-hour period
- Ongoing calls will continue during the migration
- Best time to update websites and any communication materials with (02) 7-digit contact numbers to (02) 8-digits.


## AFTER MIGRATION

- When a (02) 7-digit number is dialled domestically, an announcement will be heard with an instruction to dial the new 8-digit format (until January 2020)
- International incoming call to (02) 7-digit number will get the standard "incorrect number" announcement of the originating telco operator
- Special numbers (211, 117, 911, etc) and hashtag numbers (\#87000) will remain the same
